Box of Broadcasts

This service allows you to record TV and radio programmes over a seven-day period and watch archived programmes online. Covers all subject areas.

Building Cost Information Service

Provides accurate and updated building cost and tender price information for the construction industry and property market. Only accessible at City Campus. You must turn off pop up blockers to access this resource. Please ask library staff for the username & password.

Credo Reference

This service gives access to the *Dictionary of Construction and Architecture*.

IHS Technical Indexes

Provides access to *Specify-It* and the *Construction Information Service* which provides access to industry information, British Standards and legislation for building, construction, engineering and design.







Useful websites
